1. Determine who the target audience will attend
 - a. Scouts of the troop
 - b. Parents of the Scouts
 - c. Troop Committee
 - d. Any leaders who will attend camp
 - e. Webelos or local fifth graders & their parents
2. Set date & time
 - a. Determine convenient, comfortable location
 - b. Remember you want a big crowd to attend
 - c. Make decision about Order of the Arrow elections
 - d. Is this the same night as the FOS presentation?
3. Promote attendance at your Camp Promotions Night
 - a. Troop newsletter & 5th grade parents letter
 - b. E-mails
 - c. Posters at meeting
 - d. Invitation flyers at school
4. Secure materials and manpower for a great promotion
 - a. Review all the materials in the Camp promotions Packet
 - b. Check Audio/Visual equipment for CD production
 - c. Run copies for handouts to parents & Scouts
 - d. Utilize Order of the Arrow members of troop to help
 - e. Run through the agenda with promotion leadership team
